

PCSA – Equipment Director

It has been my pleasure to take on the role of Equipment Director for the Peterborough City Soccer Association.

This year the position saw a huge increase in responsibility. Not only did I manage an increase in the number of PCSA players, but added 85+ players for the Academy as well as 200+ campers for the PCSA summer camp. This year also included an increase in coaches/managers, technical staff and camp counsellors.

I tried to use local businesses to fill some of these orders. L&M Taylor managed a bulk of the PCSA orders for each team as well as the Academy. I also used them to purchase several size 1 customized mini balls for the U6/U7 teams. Branded Merchandise worked very quickly to fill our order for the camper t-shirts and Soccer Plus International was able to get 175 soccer balls in a matter of a couple of weeks.

Through this process I have worked closely with the staff at *L&M Taylor Soccer* and feel that they have been very professional, helpful and I would be happy to work with them again in the future. I have also been fortunate enough to have developed good relationships with many local businesses that we have used this year. They have each helped me as the Equipment Director to be able to distribute the necessary items by the dates needed.

All fittings for the 2015 have been complete and the order is being placed with L&M Taylor. We are hoping for distribution of all equipment by March 2015. The PCSA have decided to use UMBRO again as we have been very pleased with their quality of clothing as well as their ability to accommodate our maroon club colour.

This year I have found the increase in duties very time consuming, but have enjoyed the challenges this job brings.
