LEAGUES REP REPORT

Peterborough City Soccer Association fielded 35 teams from U8 to Senior in 2014. These teams played in the East Central District Soccer League (8 teams), Durham Region Soccer League (12 teams), Central East Soccer League (4 teams), Central Girls Soccer League (4 teams), Central Soccer League (4 teams), Ontario Women's Soccer League (Senior Women) and the Ontario Soccer League (U21 Men and Senior Men).

This was the first year of full implementation of OSA's Long Term Player Development matrix, which had a big impact on league structures as well as travel and festival options for U12 and younger teams. Our U8 - U12 teams played in the ECDSL (8 teams) and in the DRSL (12 teams). There were no scores or standings in these divisions, which permitted coaches to focus on player development instead of results. Games were still challenging and competitive, it's just that there was less emphasis on the final score. Success at this age is measured by player development and retention. In previous years, many of these teams would have played competitively in the CESL, CGSL or CSL.

All of our competitive-age teams (U13 and up) had a successful season and were great ambassadors for the club in league, cup and tournament play. Most notably, the U14 Girls (Mike Everson) finished second in the CGSL Level 3 Division and will move up to the OYSL (Provincial Level 1) next year. The last time a Peterborough City girls team played at the top provincial level was in 2004 when the U15 Girls finished ninth in the OYSL.

The U15 Girls (Ken Wheeler) were runners-up in both the CGSL Division 1 league and cup competitions. The U14 Girls and the U15 Girls also won their respective divisions in the Peterborough Challenge Cup.

The U13 Girls (Brad Collyer) came in first in both the CESL league and cup competitions and were runners-up in the Peterborough Challenge Cup.

The U15 Boys Maroon (Biren Patel) took gold at the Ottawa Icebreaker Tournament as well as the Heart of York Tournament. The U17 Boys (Gareth Wilson) were runners-up at the Peterborough Challenge Cup.

The U13 Boys Maroon (Bruce Rowe) were runners-up in both the CESL league and cup competitions.

The U21 Men won the OSL Central Region East Division and had four players in the top ten scoring list. Trevor Bartoli received the league's MVP Award. The Senior men finished 6th in their first season back in the OSL Central Premier Division.

The competitive league landscape for U13-U18 players will look vastly different in 2015. The CESL has been disbanded. All U13 teams will compete in District Leagues. The U14 - U18 Regional Leagues operated by the CSL (Boys) and the CGSL (Girls) will shrink from 32 teams to 16 per age division. All remaining teams will play in District Leagues whose structure is still being developed, but will most likely include teams from several neighboring districts and will have a smaller geographic footprint than the CSL and CGSL.
