DIRECTOR OF COACHING REPORT

The PCSA continues to be one of the leaders within the ECOSA region as the OSA continues to grow and develop their LTPD and Senior (Regional and District) programs.

LTPD – Now in the third year in full effect, the PCSA is in compliance with the OSA LTPD program. Over the past year and numerous meeting with LTPD coaches, parents, board members and the OSA the program is achieving their goals.

In 2016 the PCSA held several meetings with the DOC, the lead technical coach and coaches of the LTPD programs and created a completed plan which included practice session, communication and feedback and for the entire season. This program was created, monitored and communicated through the lead technical coach Roger Jenkins. Roger shared this information with all of the coaches and DOC and will be reviewed, discussed and a plan will be prepared for the 2017 season.

The PCSA will continue with the 6-7 year old development program and for 2017 will see the introduction of 5 year olds. We will see more games being played in the 2017 schedule. We will try and keep the girls and boys separated which always depends on numbers. The program will continue to run on Tuesdays and Thursday nights during the summer. Tuesday night will be a technical session with Thursday game nights. Roger will be working with the two technical coaches Leanne McLaughlin and Dan Moore at this age group.

PCSA U8 – This program continued in house and was a very successful year in player development. Tuesday and Thursday nights work for this program and we will continue next year with Tuesday nights being technical with Thursday nights being game night. ECOSA continued with running Festivals for this age group which Peterborough participated in and had very good results in player development. The other areas that participated were Lindsay, Port Hope and Cobourg. In 2017 Durham will be expanding their LTPD to include this age group. The technical team have been discussing whether or not to participate in this league.

PCSA U9 – U12 – 2016 was a very successful year in both player development and team play. Coaches placed their teams in the correct Tier Level with all teams experiencing success. In some cases, when age groups had two teams the coaches placed both teams in Tier 2 which ended up having a positive result in player development. We do not need to rush player development. Moving forward we will place all PSCA U9 teams in Tier 2. We look forward to continued success (player development) in the DRSL in 2017.

PCSA U13 – 18 – Was a very good year for most team that competed at the youth level. The majority of our teams finished in the top half of their leagues. There will be some changes to leagues again next year. The old CESL is trying to bring back their league which will present a few benefits to the PCSA. The CESL will cover the area from Scarborough to Peterborough. Competition will remain at the same level but travel times will be decrease. ECOSA is working with other districts and more information will follow. Once the league is finalized we will be discussing how the league is structured with their divisions with all of the coaches that it effects to ensure teams are placed in the correct competitive divisions.
