- Prepare written training session plans and make them available to the Academy coaches
- Provide session plans and other material to PCSA webmaster for Academy web page
- Supervise and be responsible for players at all times during training and match days, ensuring the safety of all
- Attend Academy tryouts, team tryouts, PCSA tournaments and games in order to identify players that would benefit from attending the Academy
- Promote the Academy program at parent information meetings
- Prepare a budget and meet financial targets set by the PCSA Board
- Be able to communicate with and motivate young players aged 9 15 and parents
- Oversee the progression of players holistically (physical, technical/tactical, social/emotional, physiological)
- Provide player evaluations
- Follow and enforce all PCSA Code of Conduct policies and other policies and procedures
- Be enthusiastic. Set high expectations from players and coaches. Have a disciplined yet sympathetic approach being sensitive to player's ages and stages of development
- Submit written status reports and time sheets monthly and a year-end final report
