Position Summary: The technical coaches assist the Director of Coaching and Lead Technical Team Coaches in all aspects of our player development program, including planning and running indoor and outdoor training sessions, player evaluation, and mentoring of team coaches during practice sessions and game situations

Duties and Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Follow and enforce all relevant PCSA policies and procedures
- On field coaching/training – attending training sessions for your assigned age group, working with coaching staff to assist with player development, practice plans, etc.
- Follow the OSA LTPD coaching curriculum guidelines
- Assist in the development and implementation of a coaching upgrading strategy for the PCSA
- Attend all tryout dates
- Follow up with any coaching issues with the Director of Coaching
- Attend all PCSA coaches meeting (total of four per year) and technical coaching meetings (quarterly).

Qualifications:

The preferred candidate will have as a minimum Provincial C Licence coaching certification or equivalent and minimum 5 years coaching experience at the competitive level. Previous playing and coaching experience at a high level as well as coaching certifications are key factors in selecting technical coaches.

The successful candidate must provide a current police check.

Compensation: These positions carry an honorarium commensurate with experience and qualifications as approved by the PCSA Board.
