#ECOSA District: PCSA, Cobourg, Kawartha Lakes, and Cavan Soccer Clubs

The snow has melted, why can't we start practices on a turf field now?

The turf fields (Fleming College, TASS) that the Department of Recreation issues Permits for are closed until further notice. Trent University is not permitting rental of their facilities at this time.

When can we play on the grass fields?

Field Permits and time/date allocations of fields are determined by the Department of Recreation.

The final "GO" can only be given by the Peterborough City Department of Recreation under the governance of the Peterborough County Health Unit.

As of this date, the Department of Recreation has not determined when they will open their outdoor recreation fields.

Why can't we play games while we are in the "RED" zone?

The Peterborough County Health Unit has mandated that **only socially distanced skills training** is permitted while we are in the Red Zone.

What happens when we move into the "ORANGE, YELLOW, GREEN" zone?

The Peterborough County Health Unit will determine the level of play, the number of players permitted in a bubble, as well as the area players can travel within.

Who, and Where will we play if we are allowed to travel?

Cavan is the only "rep" soccer club within our Health District if we are permitted travel within the Peterborough County Health District.

PCSA, Cobourg, Kawartha Lakes, and Cavan Soccer Clubs are within the ECOSA District if we are permitted to play out of our Health District

My age group has enough players to form two or more teams. What will happen if we play in an ECOSA organized league?

Ages with a large roster will be split up into teams. ECOSA will determine which bubble each of these teams will be placed into. As we are not guaranteed that these teams will be in the same bubble, these teams may need to conduct separate practices for the remainder of the season.

Do I have to buy a new uniform?

Uniforms that were purchased for the 2020 season will be used for the 2021 season.

U6-U9 players will receive a practice shirt with their registration.

New (to our club) players and those wishing to purchase additional items will have access to a full list of club merchandise

When will the soccer season start?

Our Club's Return to Play has been approved by Soccer Canada, Ontario Soccer and ECOSA.

We await the "GO" from the Peterborough City Recreation Department before announcing the start of our Club's activities.

The final "GO" to start training and apply for field times can only be given by the Peterborough City Department of Recreation under the governance of the Peterborough County Health Unit.

As of this date, the Department of Recreation has not determined when they will open their outdoor recreation fields.
