#### A Guide for 2022



## Background



Due to the decrease in 2022 Match Official registrations province wide and with our objective for the 2022 Outdoor season to avoid cancelling games, we have introduced the "**1+1 Assigning System**". This recommendation has received Board of Directors approval.

This is a system where there are 2 officials assigned to a game, one in the role of Referee and one in the role of 4<sup>th</sup> Official. There would be no Assistant Referees assigned.

Due to the fact that no Assistant Referees may be assigned, multiple age groups and levels of competition could recruit a volunteer to assist the Referee team.

## I don't know how!



The expectations of the Volunteer Assistant Referee are minimal.

- WAVE the 'flag' if a coach is requesting a substitution
- WAVE the 'flag' when the ball totally and completely crosses the touchlines or goal line and goes out of play.

All we ask is that we provide a safe and fair environment for all involved in the game.


 We are requesting this. Could be a flag, pinnie or other item. Please try your best to point either towards the Penalty area or to the base of the corner flag.






# **Expectations for 2022**
