## PETERBOROUGH CHALLENGE CUP AND FESTIVAL

### Parking at Eastgate - Beavermead

The parking lot in Beavermead Park is quite small. If you park illegally at Beavermead Park you will get a \$40 ticket from the Peterborough parking officer, that includes the grass verges around the perimeter of the parking lot. When the small lot at Beavermead is full please use the main parking lot on Ashburnham Drive or one of the overflow parking\* areas. It is only a short walk from there to Beavermead.

**Rule of thumb:** If there is not a white line on both sides of your vehicle at Beavermead you will get a ticket.

Please be courteous with the security attendants. They are not trying to harass you, they are trying to prevent you from getting a ticket.

You can also park in the Parks Canada Trent-Severn Waterway Headquarters visitor parking lot directly across from Eastgate Park. Please observe all parking signs and do not park on the grass or access routes.

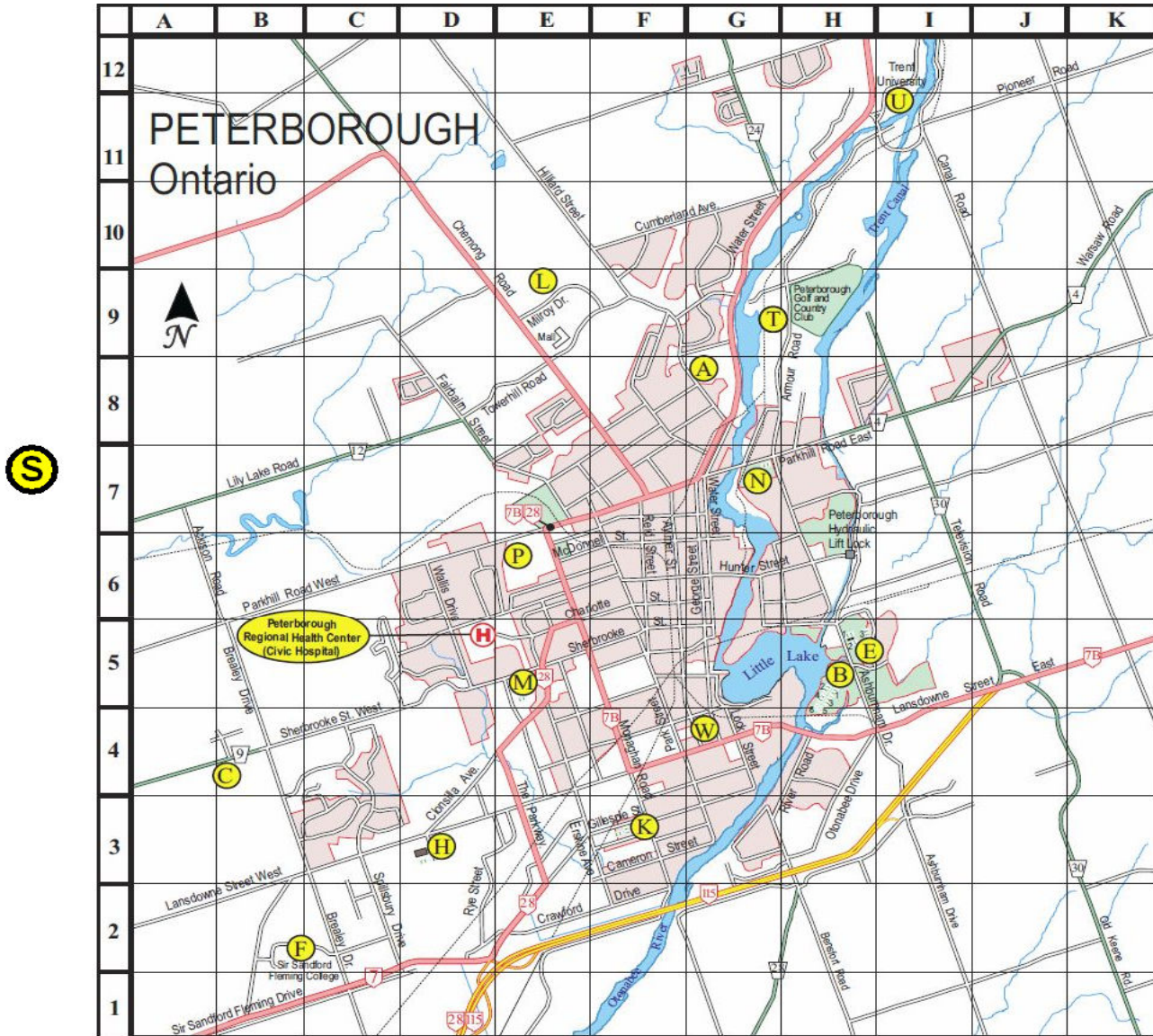

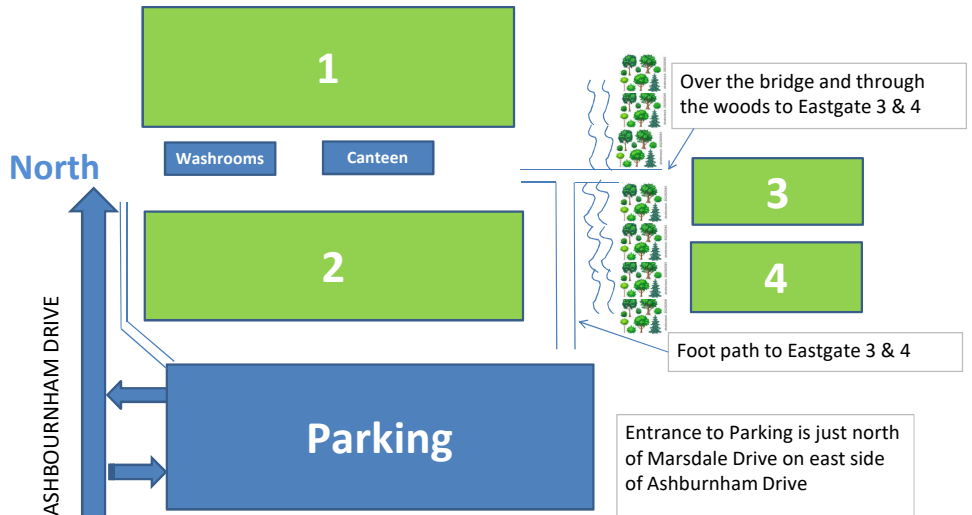

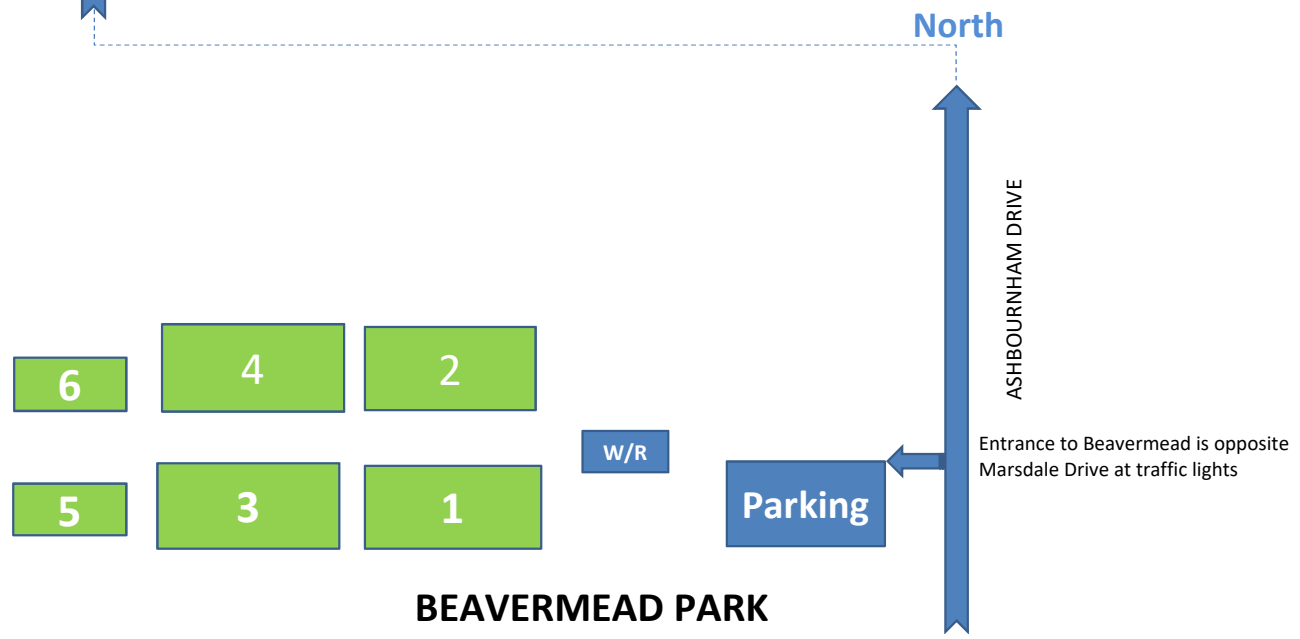

 The first place team in Group B gets a bye to the semifinal.  
 The remaining 4 teams in Group B play a third group game for points against a new opponent.  
 Only one possible matchup ensures each team in the group plays a new opponent, therefore previous ranking is irrelevant.  
 After the third game, the Group B teams are ranked again and the top team advances to the semifinal.

Tiebreakers 1. Head to head. 2. Goal difference - maximum goal spread is (+/-) 5 per game. 3. Least goals against. 4. Most Fair Play Points (FPP). 5. Coin toss.

Fleming #1 (west) is on the left hand side closest to the parking lot as you enter the fields. Fleming #2 (east) is on the right.  
 Fleming turf fields are located on the campus of Sir Sandford Fleming College in the south-west end of the city on Brealey Drive between Lansdowne Street and North Monaghan Parkway. They are identified with an "F" on the City Fields page of the schedule.  
 From the city centre, drive west on Sherbrooke Street or Lansdowne Street and take Brealey Drive south to the main entrance (Fleming College Way). Drive past the soccer fields, then turn right on Groombridge Way. The parking lot overlooking the soccer fields is on the right (Birch Lot). Parking in this lot is free.  
 Coming into the city, take the Airport Road exit from Hwy 7/115 and drive north. Airport Road changes to Brealey Drive at the North Monaghan Parkway.  
 \*\*Travel time from Fleming to Eastgate is approximately 15 minutes via Brealey Drive, Sir Sandford Fleming Drive, Hwy 115 (TCH) and Ashburnham Drive.
